

All About Incentives

Projected Weatherization Incentives (effective date: 7/1/22)

Efficiency Vermont (non-Vermont Gas heating customers)

- Base Incentive: 75% of weatherization, moisture management, and ventilation project costs up to a total incentive payment of \$2,000.
- Enhanced Moderate-Income Incentive: 75% of weatherization, moisture management, and ventilation project costs up to a total incentive payment of \$5,000.

Vermont Gas Heating Customers*

- Base Incentive: 50% of eligible air sealing and insulation costs up to a total incentive payment of \$3,500.
- Enhanced Moderate-Income Incentive: 75% of air sealing and insulation costs up to a total incentive payment of \$5,000.

*Townhouse condo units using Vermont Gas for heating are eligible for a \$750 rebate.

Projected incentive levels may change.

Enhanced Moderate-Income Incentive Chart

You qualify if you are below the income listed for your household size and location.

Income is defined as the total annual gross income of all family and non-family members 18+ years old living within the household. To calculate income, take the monthly amount from the last one-to-two paychecks for yourself and the people in your household (before taxes) and multiply by 12. Include all wages, including regular salaries and overtime. If you are self-employed, use the previous month of pretax income and multiply by 12.

Income documentation will be required for enhanced rebates.

→ How does the process work?

After your project is complete, then the Energy Co-op will invoice you for the remaining balance (this is for the cost of the project not subtracting incentives), and then submit the incentive request for the incentive to be paid to you. You will receive an email notification that you will need to respond to.

→ How long does it take?

Allow at least 60 calendar workdays to receive your incentive check.

→ When do I need to pay my invoice?

You have 30 days to pay the remaining balance. If requested, the incentive rebate can be paid directly to the Energy Co-op of Vermont, and then you would be responsible to pay any remaining balance.
